The modest endowment of the College was lost; Confederate bonds had proved to be a poor investment. Reconstruction days permitted little affluence. Even so, President John M. P. Atkinson, who had led the College since 1857, determined to recognize the centennial year. At his request Mr. Hugh Blair Grigsby, a well known historian in Virginia, delivered the commencement address which traced the first hundred years of hampden-sydney s history. Our greatest opportunity in commemorating the two hundredth anniversary stands on the shoulders of such determination and devotion. The Bicentennial Commission undertook the responsibility for presenting a celebration which would extend over the four years the Class of 1976 was in college. Their purpose was to stir an intellectual enthusiasm on the campus, to strengthen an appreciation of the heritage of the college, and to create a vision of the role of hampden-sydney during her third century of service.
