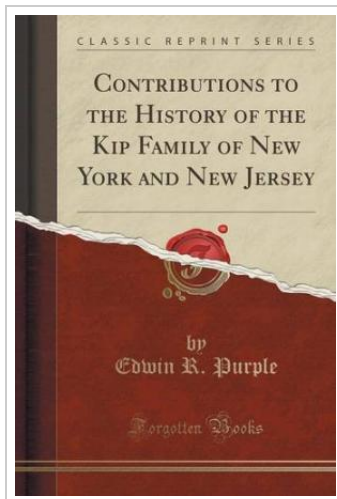




Contributions to the History of the Kip Family of New York and New Jersey (Classic Reprint)

After the lapse of two hundred and forty years, but little change has occurred in the spelling of the name, the chief and only one of which we are aware, being the addition of another p, by a limited number of some of the different branches of the family. Kip is the present generally accepted orthography of the name, and this appears to be in accordance with the early usage of the progenitors of the family in New York. The English equivalent for the Dutch word Kip is Hen or Chicken, and by following Mr. Mark Antony Lower's ingenious method of accounting for surnames, the curious may here find the true significance of the name, and will, perhaps, the more readily be led to assume that this is its proper...



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
