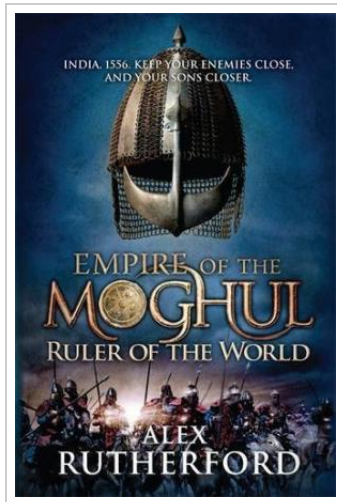




Empire of the Moghul: Ruler of the World (Paperback)
