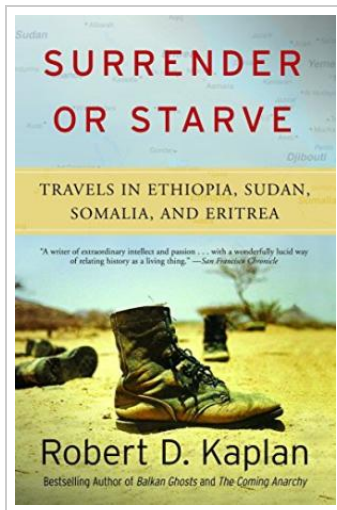




Surrender Or Starve (Paperback)
