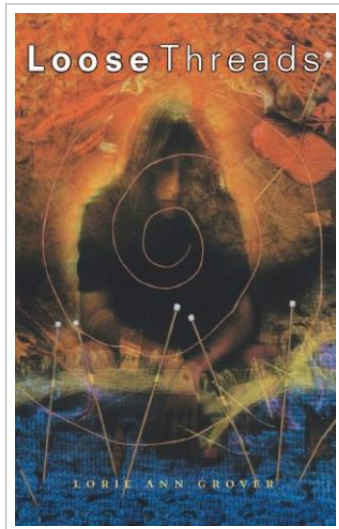




Loose Threads
