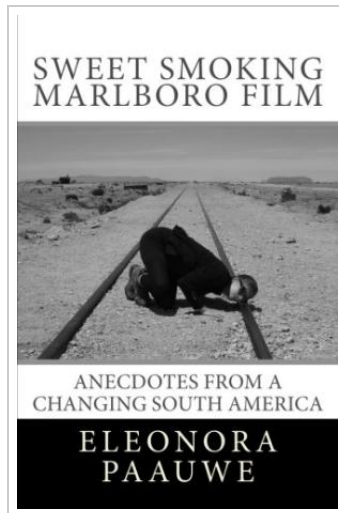




Sweet Smoking Marlboro Film: Anecdotes from a Changing South America (Paperback)
