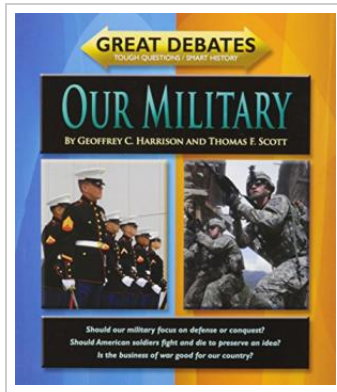




Our Military
