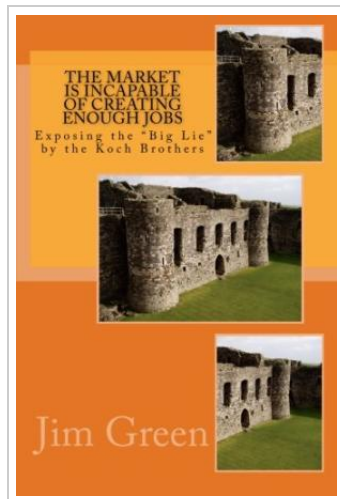




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The Market Is Incapable of Creating Enough Jobs: Exposing the Big Lie by the Koch Brothers
