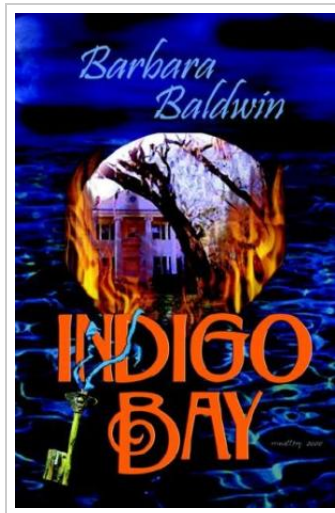




Indigo Bay (Paperback)
