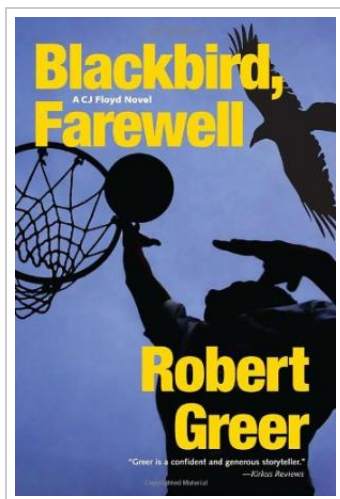




Blackbird, Farewell
