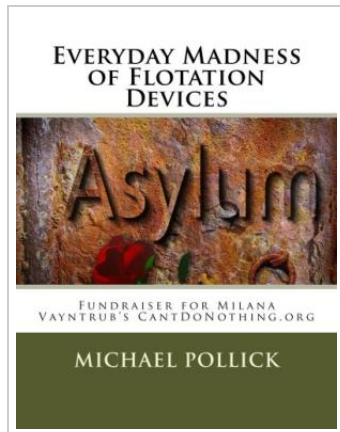




Everyday Madness of Flotation Devices: Fundraiser for Milana Vayntrub's CantdoNothing.Org (Paperback)
