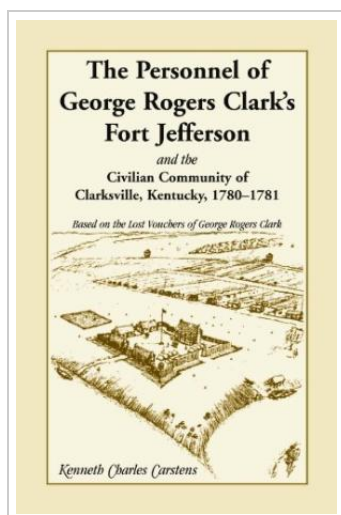



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The Personnel of George Rogers Clark's Fort Jefferson and the Civilian Community of Clarksville

Newly discovered records found in the unpublished George Rogers Clark Papers at the Virginia State Library prove that more than five hundred persons garrisoned, lived, farmed and died in this remote settlement. The economic vouchers and records of George Rogers Clark open a new window on the lives of the people who inhabited this fort. We can reconstruct their activities by noting what kind of cloth they required for their clothing; what provisions were required to outfit a military expedition; who got married and who was court-martialed. Genealogists can find the names of their ancestors among the lists in this volume and in the index. Re-enactors can formulate accurate portrayals based upon the descriptions of clothing and accoutrements. The book begins with a roster of names in the List of Companies. This is followed by the alphabetical List of Families. A chronological List of Deaths and a calendar of Fort Jefferson activities rounds out this section. The main portion of...



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
