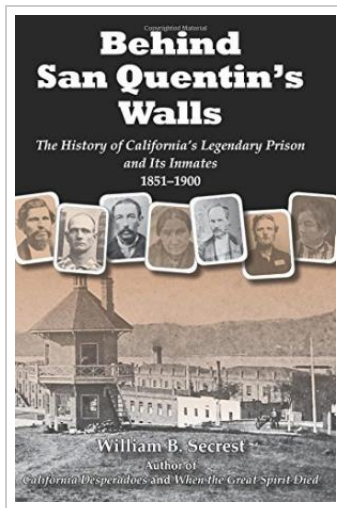




Behind San Quentin's Walls: The History of California's Legendary Prison and Its Inmates, 1851-1900
