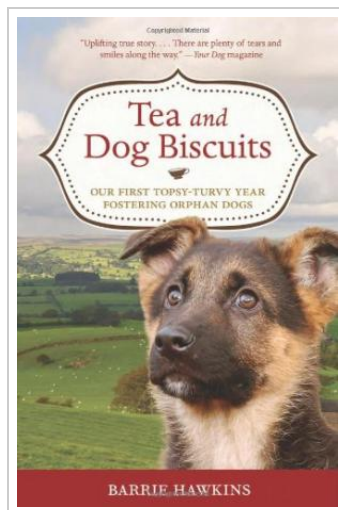




Tea and Dog Biscuits: Our First Topsy-Turvy Year Fostering Orphan Dogs
