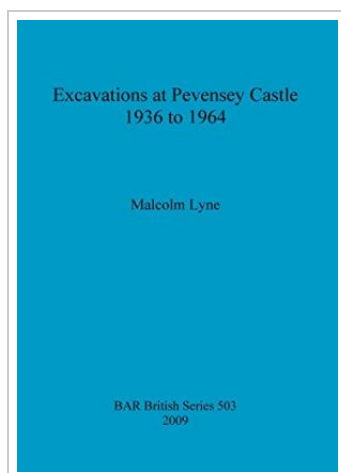




Excavations at Pevensey Castle 1936 to 1964 British Archaeological Reports British Series

This volume presents and reassesses the hitherto unpublished excavations which took place at Pevensey Castle in 1936-39 and 1964. Pevensey was part of the Saxon Shore defences, and was subsequently the site of a major Norman castle, although semi-ruinous by the end of the fourteenth century. As well as detailing the Roman and post-Roman structures, chapters cover the landscape, coins, small finds and pottery. This item ships from multiple locations.
