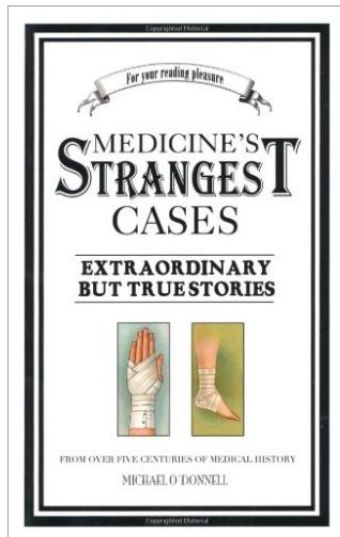




Medicine's Strangest Cases: Extraordinary But True Tales from Over Five Centuries of Medical History
