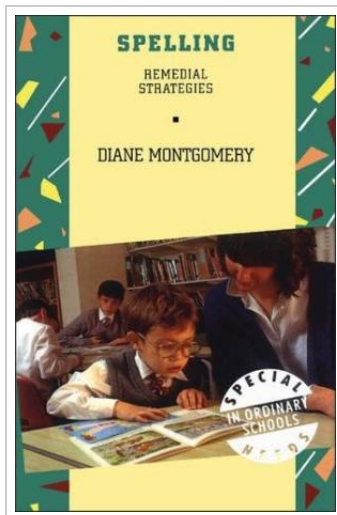




Spelling: Remedial Strategies
