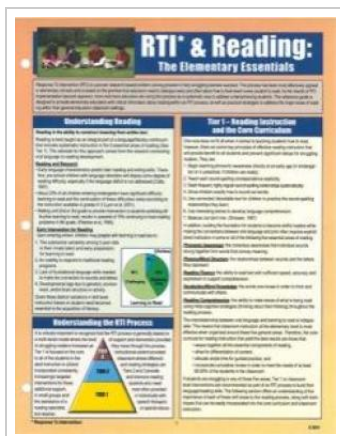




RTI and Reading: The Elementary Essentials
