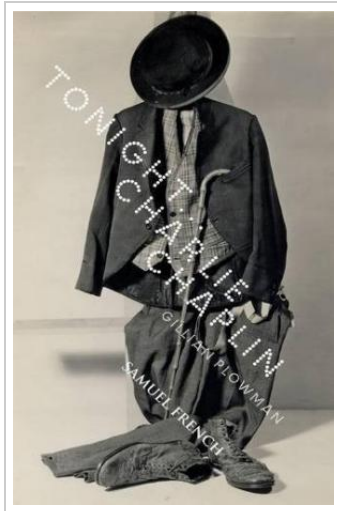




Tonight.Charlie Chaplin (Paperback)
