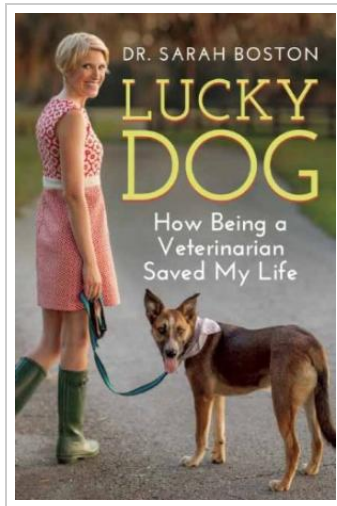




Lucky Dog: How Being a Veterinarian Saved My Life
