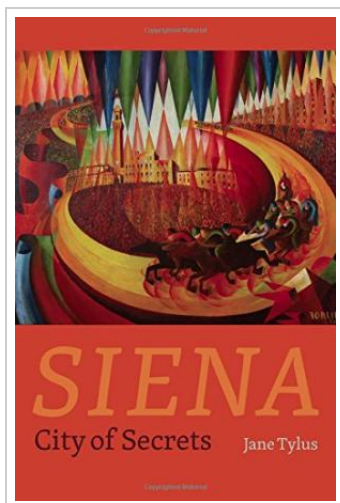




Siena: City of Secrets
