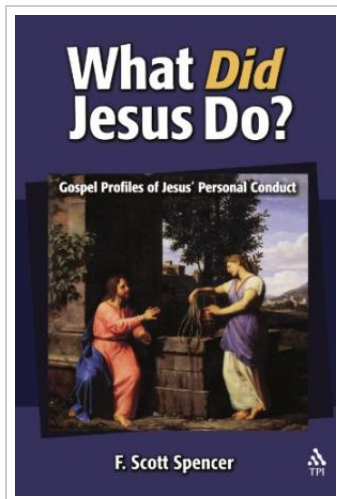




What Did Jesus Do?: Gospel Profiles of Jesus Personal Conduct

What Would Jesus Do is a popular phrase in Christian circles, but answers to that question might be more on-target if we spent more time exploring, as Scott Spencer has, What Did Jesus Do. Spencer examines both the Synoptics and the Gospel of John as he tries to catch a wide-angled vision of Jesus behavior in the gospels. Rather than focus on sayings or pronouncements as an authoritative code of conduct, he studies Jesus deeds or actions as keys to his identity and vocation. While not ignoring Jesus teaching, this study is more interested in discovering how Jesus personally lived up to his own moral instruction -- his personal conduct. Chapters are devoted to Jesus actions with respect to his family, his friends, his body, his possessions, his work, his reputation, and the environment. Spencer suggests paths -- and pitfalls -- for relating Jesus personal conduct to individual behavior, how we might move from what Jesus did in the New Testament to what we should do today. F.
