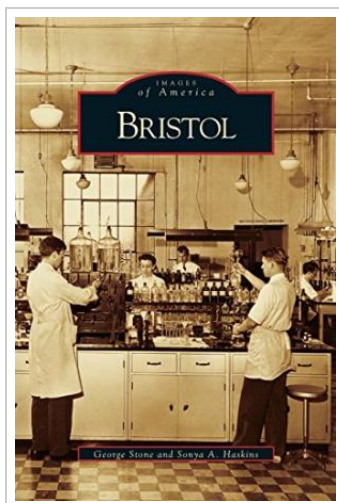




## Bristol (Hardback)

During the Civil War, Bristol was a vital railway link between the North and the South, and it later became known as the birthplace of country music.
