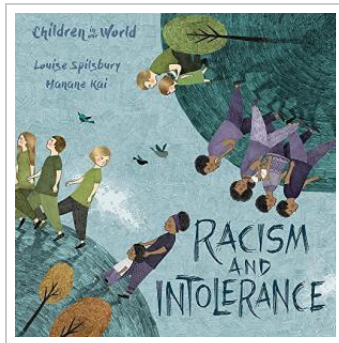




Children in Our World: Racism and Intolerance (Hardback)
