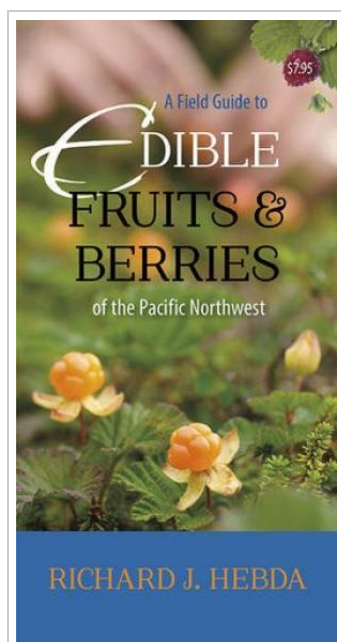




Field Guide to Edible Fruits and Berries of the Pacific NorthWest
