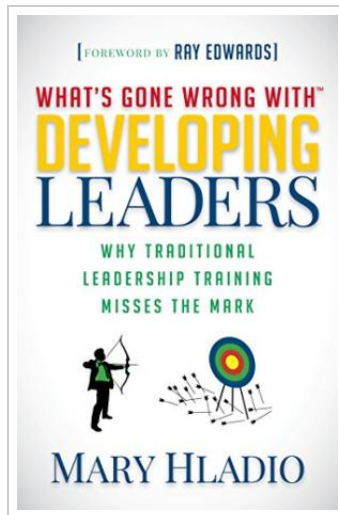




Developing Leaders: Why Traditional Leadership Training Misses the Mark (Paperback)
