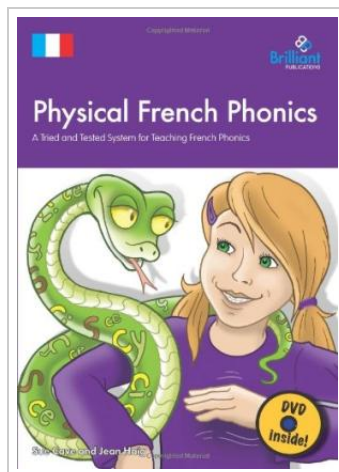




Physical French Phonics: A Tried and Tested System for Teaching French Phonics (Mixed media product)
