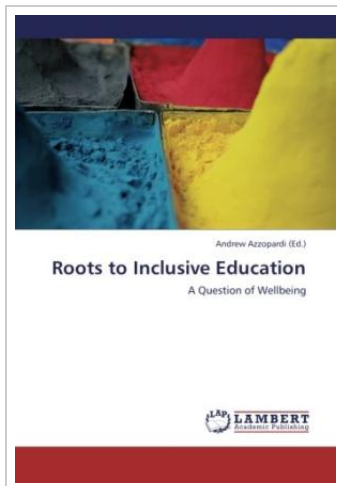




Roots to Inclusive Education
