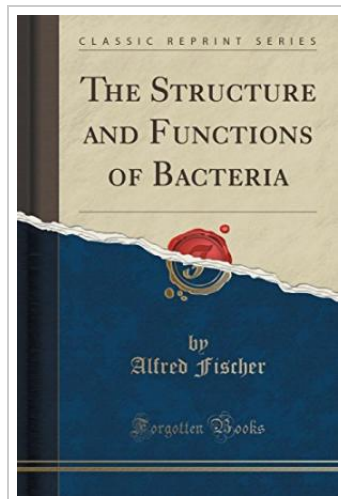

Furthermore, it seemed desirable to point out and emphasize the advancement that general physiology has received from bacteriological investigations. Finally, an attempt has been made to remove the bacteria from the isolated position to which their morphological and physiological peculiarities had relegated them, and, by comparative...
