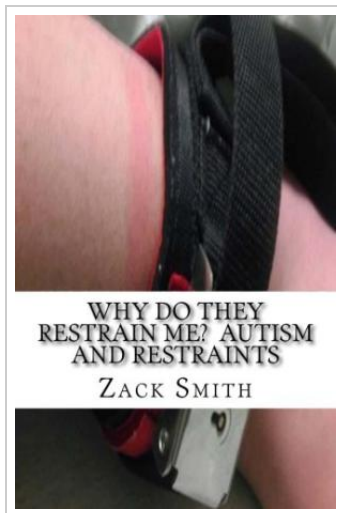




Why Do They Restrain Me? Autism and Restraints (Paperback)
