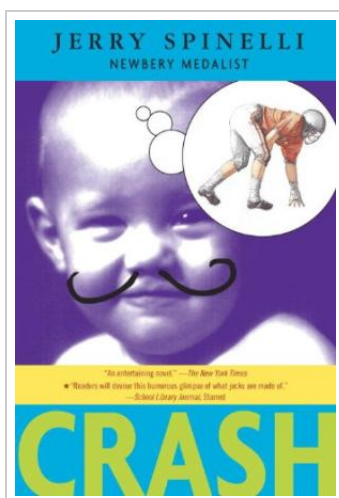




Crash (Paperback)
