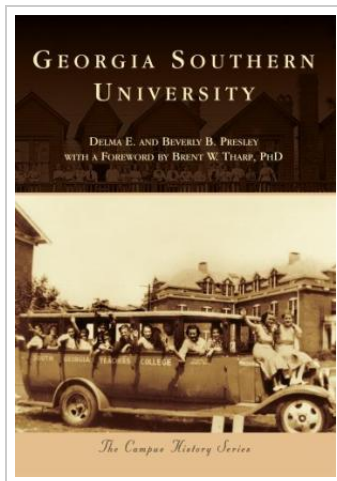




Georgia Southern University Campus History
