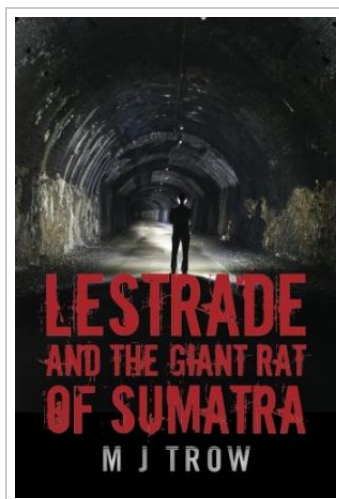




Lestrade and the Giant Rat of Sumatra (Paperback)
