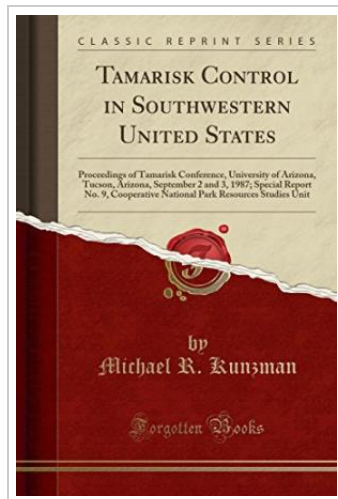



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1958, he was reassigned to Glacier Bay National Park, where he was later promoted to chief park

reassigned to staff park ranger and ultimately to Chief, Division of Natural Resources

Management. Finally, he returned to Lake Mead National Recreation Area in 1986, to serve as
