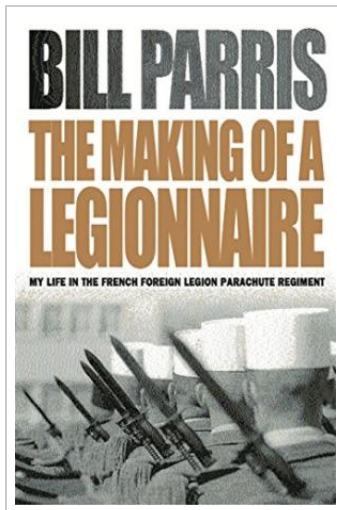




The Making of a Legionnaire: My Life in the French Foreign Legion Parachute Regiment
